- * Endowment Trust Fund Scholarship (PK-8 Catholic only)

Georgia Residents Assisting Children's Education (G.R.A.C.E.) Scholars Inc. makes available scholarships for tuition to children from low to middle income families in grades K-12 for use at approved Catholic schools located in the State of Georgia.

Families that are Georgia residents and have a child enrolled in a Georgia primary or secondary public school and / or are eligible to enroll in a qualified kindergarten program or pre-kindergarten program are eligible for G.R.A.C.E. Scholars, Inc.

According to the State of Georgia, G.R.A.C.E. Scholars Inc. is required to award at least 90% of all of the annual donations to the issuing of scholarships. GRACE Scholars, Inc. scholarships may only be offered to students who have attended public school immediately prior to their enrollment into the Catholic school of their choice and that qualifies the child.
